

TASK 1 READING

The place where ice-cream was invented

When you think Italy, you think football, pasta, ice-cream. It was winter and I was in northern Italy, feeling a bit <u>lonely</u>. I had the number of an Italian ice-cream maker, so I gave him a call. He picked me up at *Dobbiaco*, in the South Tirol region, and we drove to a valley just over the border in Veneto. With a theatrical gesture he announced: "Here, the ice-cream makers live!" It <u>sounded</u> so fabulous that I immediately felt I wanted to write a book about it.


So, my book is about an ice-cream maker from Italy who has a shop in Rotterdam, where I live. The book is based on the tradition of Italian ice-cream makers travelling abroad to their ice-cream <u>parlours</u> at the end of spring and returning to Italy at the end of autumn. This trip is made by a lot of ice-cream makers, to and from cities in the Netherlands, Belgium, Austria and Germany.

Half of the <u>inhabitants</u> in *Valle di Cadore* are ice-cream makers or work in a gelateria. There are six or seven small villages in the valley, and in winter everyone is there; but in spring and summer it is empty: the pizzeria opens only at weekends and there is no queue at the bakery. Before refrigerators, you needed ice or snow to make ice-cream, and there are a lot of high snowy mountains around there. Several old men in the valley told me their great-grandfathers had invented ice-cream.

Some people think the Chinese <u>invented</u> ice-cream. Marco Polo is said to have brought <u>recipes</u> to Europe from China. But obviously Italians disagree – very strongly. Italian ice-cream is different from other ice-creams around the world. I went to an international ice-cream show, and you could really taste the difference. Americans like ice-cream really hard, with no air in it; in real Italian ice-cream, there is a lot of air to make it soft. Australians like it with a crunch – for example from roasted almonds.

I think I have tasted 64 flavours of ice-cream and disliked only three. I have tried ice-cream of everything – blood, bread, cooked ham.... I tried one made from an energy drink, which was really green. I thought being an ice-cream maker must be the best job in the world. I am <u>less</u> romantic about it now. Everyone goes for ice-cream in summer, but they don't know the story of the people who make it, sometimes 17 hours a day. It's hard, and there are people who didn't want to go into the ice-cream business but had to because of family tradition. This is what my book is about.






